AN ACT to restore the Jurisdiction of the Court of Requests holden in and for the District of Hobart Town. [7th January, 1857.]

WHEREAS by Section 205 of "The Common Law Procedure PREAMBLE. Act" it was enacted that the Jurisdiction of any Court of Requests 18th Viet. No. 9, holden in and for the District of Hobart Town should be limited to sect. 205. Actions to an Amount not exceeding Ten Pounds-And whereas it is expedient to restore the Jurisdiction of the said Court in Actions to an Amount not exceeding Thirty Pounds—Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:
