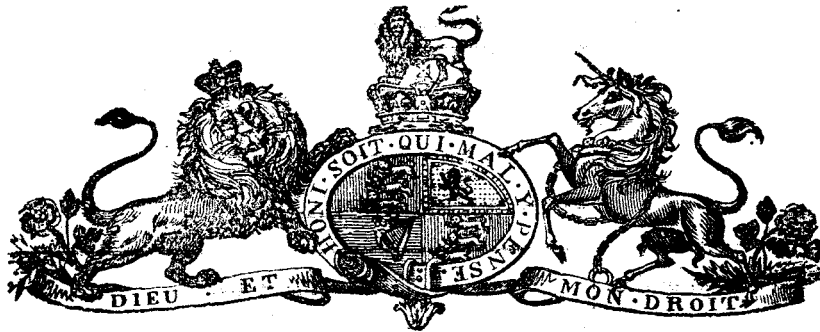

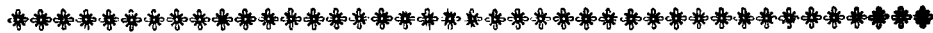

AN ACT to reduce the Salary and Allowances of every future Governor of *Tasmania*.

[Reserved, 27 December, 1872; Royal Assent proclaimed, 14 April, 1874.]

WHEREAS, by reason of the change which has taken place in the circumstances of the Colony since the passing of "The Constitutional Act," it has become desirable that the Salary and Allowances of the Governor of *Tasmania* as fixed by that Act should be reduced in the case of all future Governors of *Tasmania*: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PREAMBLE.

1 Instead of the sums set forth in Schedule B. of "The Constitutional Act" as payable for the Governor's Salary and for his Allowances and Contingent Expenses, there shall be payable out of the General Revenue of this Colony for and in respect of the Salary and Establishment of every Governor of this Colony, except His Excellency *Charles Du Cane*, Esquire, the present Governor of this Colony, the sum of £3500, and the provisions of Section Thirty of the said Act shall be applicable in respect of the said sum in the same manner as if the same had been inserted in the said Schedule instead of the sums therein specified for which the sum fixed by this Act is substituted.

Instead of sums in Schedule B. of 18 Vict. No. 17, other sums to be payable for Governor's Salary and Establishment.

2 On and after the day on which the Successor to the said *Charles Du Cane*, Esquire, takes office as the Governor of this Colony the Acts mentioned in the Schedule shall be and are hereby repealed, save as to all things duly done thereunder.
