

AN ACT to vest the Control of the Water-works at New Norfolk in the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of New Norfolk. [18 September, 1863.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to vest in the Municipal Council of the PREAMBLE. Rural Municipality of New Norfolk the powers vested in Commissioners 24 Vict. No. 17. under the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 24th Victoria, No. 17, for the management and control of the Water-works made, constructed, and maintained for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of the Town of New Norfolk with Water: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 All powers and authorities by the said recited Act of the 24th Powers vested in Victoria, No. 17, vested in Commissioners appointed under the said Act Commissioners shall, upon the commencement of this Act, be transferred to, vested in, No. 17, transferred and exercisable by the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of to Municipal New Norfolk; and for the purposes of the said Act the term "Municipal Council of New Council" shall be substituted for the term "the Commissioners" wheresoever the same is used: Provided that the said Municipal Council Municipal Council shall pay or cause to be paid to the Commissioners appointed under the cil to pay moneys said Act all moneys due and owing to the said Commissioners for and sioners. on account of any act, matter, or thing done or performed by the said Commissioners in the exercise of their duty, or by virtue of their appointment as such Commissioners.

Supply of Water to "The New Norfolk Hospital for the Insane."

2 For the purpose of affording a sufficient supply of Water to "The New Norfolk Hospital for the Insane," the said Municipal Council shall continue to the said Hospital the supply of Water now conveyed to the said Hospital, which supply shall be conveyed thereto by the pipe or pipes now used for that purpose, or by another or other pipe or pipes of the like diameter; and the control and management of the said pipes, and of the valves therein, shall be vested solely in the Commissioners appointed under *The Insane Persons' Hospitals Act* for the said Hospital.

Repeal.

3 Sections Two, Three, Four, and Five of the said Act of the 24th Victoria, No. 17, are hereby repealed.

Acts to be read together.

4 This Act and the said recited Act, except in so far as the same is altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the

Commencement of Act.

5 This Act shall come into force and take effect on and from the First day of October, 1863; and thereupon the Commissioners appointed under the said Act shall cease to hold office.
