AN ACT to amend the *Australian Commonwealth Carbide Company Agreement Act 1934.*

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Australian Commonwealth Carbide Company Agreement Act 1939.* Short title.

Australian Commonwealth Carbide Company Agreement.

2—(1) The land comprised and described in Purchase Grant Registered Volume 146, Folio 142, being thirty-one acres three roods and thirty perches situate in the Parish of Purves, in the County of Kent, now in the possession of the Company, and intended to be vested in the Company in accordance with the provisions of clause six of the agreement contained in the first schedule to the Principal Act, shall be, and the same is hereby, vested in the Company in fee simple.

(2) The Recorder of Titles, on the application of the Company, may issue to the Company a certificate of title to the said land, under the provisions of the *Real Property Act 1862*, without payment of any fee or contribution to the assurance fund.
