

ADVANCED EDUCATION AMENDMENT

No. 27 of 1980

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AN ACT to amend the Advanced Education Act 1968 to alter the constitution of the Council of Advanced Education, to provide for the remuneration of the chairman and deputy chairman of the Council, and to require its co-operation with certain co-ordinating bodies established by the Minister.

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[Royal Assent 21 May 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Advanced Education Amendment Short title. Act 1980.

Commence-

- **2**—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such date as may be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the Advanced Education Act 1968* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 3 of Principal Act (The Council of Advanced Education).

- **4**—(1) Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (3) "The" (first occurring) and substituting "Subject to subsection (3A), the";
 - (b) by omitting from that subsection "15" and substituting "16":
 - (c) by omitting from paragraph (c) of that subsection "one shall be a person who is" and substituting "two shall be persons who are";
 - (d) by inserting after that subsection the following subsection:—
 - (3A) Where an advisory council is for the time being established under section 4B of the Education Act 1932 to advise the Minister on community education in the north-western region of the State there shall, in addition to the persons who are members of the Council by virtue of subsection (3), be an additional member of the Council appointed by the Governor on the nomination of that advisory council; and, notwithstanding anything in subsection (4), the member first so appointed on the establishment of such an advisory council may be appointed for a term of less than 4 years.
 - (e) by inserting after subsection (6) the following subsection:—
 - (6A) The chairman and deputy chairman of the Council shall be entitled to such remuneration as is provided for in regulations under this Act.
 - (f) by omitting from subsection (12) "6" and substituting "8".

- (2) The person first appointed a member of the Council after the commencement of this Act as a consequence of the coming into effect of the amendment made by subsection (1) (c) may notwithstanding anything in section 3 (4) of the Principal Act be appointed for a term of less than 4 years.
- 5—Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-Amendment of section (6) and substituting the following subsection:—

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- (6) In the exercise of its functions the Council shall have Council). regard to the education provided otherwise than under this Act that is available in this State and, with a view to promoting a proper co-ordination in the provision of tertiary education in the State, the Council shall endeavour as far as practicable to co-operate with-
 - (a) the other bodies providing tertiary education in the State:
 - (b) any body established by the Minister to co-ordinate the provision of any such tertiary education.
- 6—Section 19 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in Amendment of subsection (1) the following paragraph after paragraph (b):—
 - (ba) the remuneration of the chairman and deputy chairman of the Council and the fixing of the amount thereof:
