APPROPRIATION (GENERAL ELECTION EXPENSES).

No. 32 of 1948.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine.

[23 July, 1948.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (General Election Expenses) Act 1948.

Issu and application of £7000.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, 1949, the sum of seven thousand pounds.

Appropriation of supplies.

3 The sum granted by this Act is appropriated for the purpose expressed in the schedule.

Power to Treasurer to apply moneys. 4 The Treasurer may apply any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum set forth in the schedule for the purpose therein expressed.
