## APPROPRIATION (SHIPPING FREIGHT SUBSIDY).

## No. 68 of 1953.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue an additional sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954. [9 December, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Shipping short title. Freight Subsidy) Act 1953.
- 2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Issue and Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby application of £10,000. granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1954, the sum of ten thousand pounds.

3 The sum granted by this Act is appropriated, and shall Appropriabe deemed to have been appropriated as from the first day tion. of July, 1953, for the purpose specified in the schedule in relation to the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June. 1954.

4 The purpose specified in the schedule shall not be deemed Purpose to be part of the ordinary annual services of the Government specified in within the meaning of Part IV of the Constitution Act 1934. part of ordin
