APPROPRIATION (SPECIAL GRANTS).

No. 60 of 1950.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the purposes of certain special grants. [29 November, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation (Special Grants) Act 1950*.

Appropriation and application of £17,000.

2—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is hereby appropriated accordingly) a sum not exceeding £17,000, and apply that sum for the purposes expressed in the schedule.

(2) The sum appropriated by subsection (1) of this section may be applied in the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1951, and in any subsequent financial years; and may be applied partly in one financial year and partly in any other financial year or financial years.

Grant in aid of the erection of a Community Centre at Ulverstone (on the basis of one pound for each pound actually expended upon or in connection with the erection of the Centre)	1,000
Grant to the Launceston City Mission in aid of the cost of erection of premises (on the basis of one pound for each pound actually expended upon or in connection with the erection of the said premises)	1,000

AN ACT to amend the *Public Health Act 1935*. [7 December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Health Act* Short title and citation.
