APPROPRIATION (SPECIAL GRANTS).

No. 60 of 1950.

AN ACT to appropriate and apply a sum from the Consolidated Revenue for the purposes of certain special grants. [29 November, 1950.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (Special Grants) Act 1950.

Appropriation and application of £17,000.

- **2**—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is hereby appropriated accordingly) a sum not exceeding £17,000, and apply that sum for the purposes expressed in the schedule.
- (2) The sum appropriated by subsection (1) of this section may be applied in the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1951, and in any subsequent financial years; and may be applied partly in one financial year and partly in any other financial year or financial years.

SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT—GRANTS TO INSTITUTIONS.

MISCELLANEOUS CHIEF SECRETARY.

Grant in aid of the erection of a Community Centre at Ulverstone (on the basis of one pound for each pound actually expended upon or in connection with the erection of the Centre)

Grant to Missions to Seamen Club and Hostel in aid of the purchase of land and the cost of erection of premises thereon (progress payments to be made when the land is purchased and as the erection of the premises proceeds)

Grant to Nazareth House for the Aged Poor, St. Leonards in aid of the cost of erection of additional accommodation for inmates (on the basis of one pound for each pound actually expended in connection with the extension of existing buildings used for the purposes of the said Nazareth House)

PUBLIC HEALTH.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Health Act* 1935. [7 December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Health Act Short title and citation.
- (2) The Public Health Act 1935*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
