### ANALYSIS

**AN ACT to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1931.**

**[11 November 1976]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Acts Interpretation Act* Short title and citation. 1976.

(2) The *Acts Interpretation Act* 1931, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 43 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsections:—

“(2) In any Act—

- (a) a reference to the Southern Region shall be construed as a reference to the area comprising the cities of Hobart and Glenorchy and the municipalities of Bothwell, Brighton, Bruny, Clarence, Esperance, Glamorgan, Green Ponds, Hamilton, Huon, Kingborough, New Norfolk, Oatlands, Port Cygnet, Richmond, Sorell, Spring Bay, and Tasman;
- (b) a reference to the Northern Region shall be construed as a reference to the area comprising the city of Launceston and the municipalities of Beaconsfield, Campbell Town, Deloraine, Evandale, Fingal, Flinders, George Town, Lilydale, Longford, Portland, Ringarooma, Ross, St. Leonards, Scottsdale, and Westbury; and
- (c) a reference to the North-Western Region shall be construed as a reference to the area comprising the municipalities of Burnie, Circular Head, Devonport, Gormanston, Kentish, King Island, Latrobe, Penguin, Queenstown, Strahan, Ulverstone, Waratah, Wynyard, and Zeehan.

“(3) In subsection (2) a reference to a city or municipality shall be construed as a reference to that city or municipality as it existed on 1st January 1976.”.
