- (2) The Local Government Act 1906, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section one hundred and thirty-one A of the Principal Power to Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) the word unused roads, "three" and substituting therefor the word "ten".

## ANZAC MEMORIAL HOSTEL.

No. 23 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the Anzac Memorial Hostel Act 1924.

[28 April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Anzac Memorial Hostel Short title Act 1954.
- (2) The Anzac Memorial Hostel Act 1924 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 After section two of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:--
- "3-(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the above Power to vary certain recited declaration of trust or in any supplemental agreement, provisions of deed, or declaration of trust entered into or made, after the the declaration of trust entered into or made, after the trust. date of execution of that declaration of trust but before the commencement of this section, between the trustees for the time being of the abovementioned property and any other person or persons, in relation to the conduct, carrying on, management, or maintenance of the abovementioned institution, the trustees for the time being of the abovementioned property may enter into an agreement with the committee for

the time being of the Launceston Sub-branch of the Returned Sailors', Soldiers', and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia providing for the variation of the above recited declaration of trust by the omission therefrom of any provisions prohibiting the taking into, or consumption or sale upon, the abovementioned property, or any part thereof, of any liquors.

- (2) No agreement entered into pursuant to subsection (1) of this section shall have any force or effect unless and until it has been confirmed by the votes of a majority of the members of the Launceston Sub-branch of the Sailors', Soldiers', and Airmen's Imperial League of Australia present and voting at a special general meeting of the members thereof called for the purpose.
- (3) Upon the confirmation pursuant to subsection (2) of this section of an agreement under subsection (1) of this section, any provision of the above recited declaration of trust prohibiting the taking into, or the consumption or sale upon, the abovementioned property, or any part thereof, of liquors (whether intoxicating liquors or not) shall cease to have any force or effect.".
