AN ACT to amend the *Adoption of Children Act* 1920.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Adoption of Children.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the word “seventeen” in the definition of “child” in section two thereof and substituting therefor the word “twenty-one”:

Section 2.

II. By adding at the end of the said definition the words “and includes an unmarried person over the age of twenty-one years who, since reaching an age not exceeding ten years, has been brought up, maintained, and educated by the applicant for an order of adoption of such person.”:

Section 5.

III. By expunging division (a) of paragraph III. of subsection (1) of section five thereof and substituting therefor the following new division (a)—

“(a) The person to be adopted is a child as defined by section two.”.
