BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting after the definition of "Deserted child" in section two the following new definition-
 - "'Registrar-General' means the Registrar-General appointed under the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 1895.":
- II. By inserting after section two the following new section two A-
 - "2A. From the commencement of this section, all the powers and functions conferred on a police magistrate by this Act shall, in all cases, be exercised-
 - I. In the city of Hobart, by the Registrar-General: and
 - II. In the city of Launceston, by the registrar of births and deaths for the district of Launceston appointed under the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 1895-

and the provisions of this Act shall be read and construed accordingly.":

III. By adding at the end of paragraph IV. of subsection (1) of section five the words ", except in any particular case in which it appears to the police magistrate to be undesirable, in the interests of the child, to require such consent,":
