AN ACT to amend the Acts Reprinting Act 1979 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the reprinting of Acts of the Parliament of Tasmania and of certain instruments made under the authority of those Acts and to amend the Statute Law Revision Act 1982.

## [Royal Assent 18 April 1984]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Acts Reprinting Amendment Short title. Act 1984.

Commencement. **2**—Except as provided in section 8, this Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.

Principal Act.

**3**—In this Act, the Acts Reprinting Act 1979\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 3 of Principal Act (Power to reprint Acts).

- **4**—Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:—
  - (1) The Attorney-General may cause to be compiled and published a reprint, with amendments incorporated, of any Act.

Amendment of section 4 of Principal Act (Alterations of a formal nature).

- **5**—(1) Section 4 (1) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
  - (a) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (c):—
    - (ca) where, following a reference to or a citation of an Imperial Act or a Commonwealth Act in an Act, words occur which indicate that that reference includes a reference to or citation of all subsequent enactments passed in amendment or substitution of the Imperial or Commonwealth Act so referred to or cited, those words may be omitted;
  - (b) by inserting in paragraph (g) "or altered" after "omitted".
- (2) Section 4 (2) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting ", by notice published in the *Gazette*," after "Attorney-General may".
- (3) Section 4 of the Principal Act is further amended by omitting subsection (4) and substituting the following subsection:—
  - (4) The Attorney-General may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, from time to time, vary or revoke directions issued under subsection (2).
- (4) Section 4 (5) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "or in respect of which a notice has been given under section 3 (1)".

- (5) Section 4 of the Principal Act is further amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (6):—
  - (7) The Attorney-General may issue a certificate to the effect that an alteration or amendment specified in the certificate has been effected in accordance with subsection (1); and such a certificate shall be evidence for all purposes, and be admissible in all courts, that the alteration or amendment has been lawfully made in accordance with that subsection.
  - 6—Section 5 of the Principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of section 5 of Principal Act (Duty of Government Printer to reprint Act).

- 7—Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
- Amendment of (Delegation).
- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) ", another officer employed Principal Act in the Office of the Parliamentary Counsel, or the Solicitor-General or an officer of the Law Department" after "Counsel":
- (b) by inserting in subsection (2) ", another officer employed in the Office of the Parliamentary Counsel, or the Solicitor-General or an officer of the Law Department " after "Counsel".
- 8—(1) The Statute Law Revision Act 1982\* is amended as Amendment of Statute Law follows:--Revision Act

- (a) by omitting subsection (2) of section 3;
- (b) by omitting from Part I of Schedule 2 the item relating to the Acts Reprinting Act 1979.
- (2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on 18th January 1983.
