**AN ACT to amend the Ambulance Service Act 1982 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to transitional provisions and savings.**

[Royal Assent 16 February 1983]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—This Act may be cited as the *Ambulance Service Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

**2**—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 20th January 1983. Commencement.

**3**—Schedule 6 to the *Ambulance Service Act 1982*\* is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting paragraphs (c) and (d) of clause 3 (4) and substituting the following:—

(c) Superintendent/Secretary of the Devonport and District Ambulance Board shall, on that date, be deemed to have been appointed under section 14 as regional ambulance superintendent or as assistant superintendent for the North-Western region; or

(d) Superintendent/Secretary of the Burnie and District Ambulance Board shall, on that date, be deemed to have been appointed under section 14 as regional ambulance superintendent or as assistant superintendent for the North-Western region.

(b) by omitting paragraphs (c) and (d) of clause 4 and substituting the following:—

(c) all proceedings pending immediately before that date at the suit of the Authority or an ambulance board shall be deemed to be proceedings pending on that date at the suit of the Director and all proceedings so pending at the suit of any person against the Authority or an ambulance board shall be deemed to be proceedings pending at the suit of that person against the Director;

(d) all contracts, financial agreements, financial arrangements, and financial undertakings, entered into with, and all securities lawfully given to or by, the Authority or an ambulance board and in force immediately before that date shall be deemed to be contracts, financial agreements, financial arrangements, and financial undertakings entered into with and securities given to or by the Director;
