AN ACT to provide for the application of certain  
Moneys granted to this State by the Commonwealth  
for the purposes of Forestry.

**W**HEREAS by the *Appropriation (Unemployment Relief) Act 1936* of the Commonwealth certain moneys were granted to this State in respect of the financial years ending respectively on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven and the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, upon the conditions set forth in subsection (3) of section three of that Act, to be used by the State in providing, for the purpose of relieving unemployment, assistance to forestry:

Preamble.

*Aid to Forestry (Federal Grant).*

And whereas the Federal Treasurer has determined certain conditions under which the moneys so granted in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, shall be used by the State, and has approved of a scheme of forestry operations to be carried out with the aid of such moneys :

And whereas it is desirable to make provision for the carrying out of the forestry scheme and for the application of such moneys as last aforesaid :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Aid to Forestry (Federal Grant) Act 1937*.

Interpretation.

**2** In this Act—

“The Commonwealth Act” means the *Appropriation (Unemployment Relief) Act 1936* of the Commonwealth :

“The Federal Treasurer” means the Treasurer of the Commonwealth :

“The forestry scheme” means the scheme of forestry operations referred to in section three :

“The trustees” means the Commonwealth Sub-Treasury Accountant at Hobart and the Conservator of Forests.

Forestry scheme to be carried out under direction of trustees.

**3** The scheme of forestry operations referred to in the preamble to this Act as having been approved by the Federal Treasurer, the general particulars of which are set out in the schedule, shall be carried out under the general direction of the trustees.

Trust account.

**4**—(1) For the purposes of this Act there shall be kept in the books of the Treasury a trust account to be called “The Commonwealth Aid to Forestry Trust Account, 1937-38.”

Application of moneys granted for 1937-38.

(2) All moneys received by the State under the provisions of the Commonwealth Act for the purposes mentioned in the second schedule to that Act in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, shall be paid into and credited to the said account.

*Aid to Forestry (Federal Grant).*

(3) The moneys standing to the credit of the said account shall be paid and applied by the Treasurer, on the certificate of the trustees, for the purpose of carrying out the forestry scheme, and as provided by subsection (3) of section three of the Commonwealth Act. A.D. 1937.

5 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act. Regulations.
