AN ACT to amend the Bank Holidays Act 1919

[Royal Assent 17 September 1993]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the Bank Holidays Amendment Act 1993.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Bank Holidays Act 1919* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 4 amended (Bank holidays)

- 4—Section 4 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraph:—
 - (d) 26 January, unless that day is a Saturday or Sunday in which case the following Monday;
