## AN ACT to amend the Constitution Act 1934.

[Reserved, 14 October 1969; Royal Assent proclaimed, 4 February 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania. by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution Act sad disting 1969.
- (2) The Constitution Act 1934, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Quinquennial Parliaments. 2 Section twenty-three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "five" and substituting therefor the word "three".

Non-application of amendment to the Assembly chosen in May 1969.

3 The amendment of the Principal Act effected by section two of this Act does not apply to or in relation to the Assembly chosen at the general election held on the tenth day of May 1969.
