# AN ACT to amend the Cinema Act 1962. [9 November 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Cinema Act 1972.
- (2) The Cinema Act 1962, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Objections to registration.

- 2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) thereof the word "who" (second occurring).
- 3 After section ten of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Duration and renewal of registrations and licences.

- "10A—(1) The registration under this Act of—
  - (a) a cinema; and
  - (b) a person as—
    - (i) an exhibitor; or
    - (ii) a distributor,

expires on the thirty-first day of December next after the day on which the registration was effected, but may be renewed from year to year on payment of the prescribed fee for each renewal.

"(2) A licence or limited licence under section ten expires on the thirty-first day of December next after the day on which the licence is issued, but may be renewed from year to year on payment of the prescribed fee for each renewal."

Regulations.

4 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (i) of subsection (2) thereof the words "and the fees to be paid to persons who examine applicants for licences under section ten".

Transitory

- **5**—(1) The registration of—
  - (a) a cinema; or
  - (b) a person as—
    - (i) an exhibitor; or
    - (ii) a distributor.

being a registration that is in force on the day on which this Act commences, shall expire on the thirty-first day of December 1972, but may be renewed as provided in section ten A of the Principal Act.

(2) A licence or limited licence under section ten of the Principal Act that is in force on the day on which this Act commences shall expire on the thirty-first day of December 1972, but may be renewed as provided in section ten A of that Act.
