



CREMATION AMENDMENT ACT 1983

TABLE OF PROVISIONS

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 5A of *Cremation Act 1934* (Fees in relation to cremations, &c.).

AN ACT to amend the Cremation Act 1934 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the publication by a cremation authority of its scale of fees.

[Royal Assent 2 December 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Cremation Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

2—Section 5A of the *Cremation Act* 1934* is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting from subsection (1) “with the approval of the Minister, make and publish in the *Gazette*” and substituting “by public notice, prescribe”;

(b) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (1):—

(1A) A public notice prescribing a scale of fees under subsection (1) is not a statutory rule within the meaning of the *Rules Publication Act* 1953.

(c) by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1)—

“cremation authority” means the local authority, trustees, or other person by which or by whom a crematory is maintained and conducted, but does not include the Southern Regional Cemetery Trust;

“public notice” means publication in the *Gazette* and in a daily newspaper circulating in the locality of the crematory.
