**AN ACT to repeal the *Cinema Act 1962*****[Royal Assent 10 December 1992]**

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**Short title**

**1**—This Act may be cited as the *Cinema Act (Repeal) Act 1992*.

### Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

### Interpretation

3—In this Act—

“**Cinema Board**” means the Cinema Board continued under the *Cinema Act 1962*;

“**commencement day**” means the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;

“**Crown**” means the Crown in right of Tasmania;

“**legal proceedings**” includes an arbitration;

“**right**” includes an entitlement, a power and a privilege.

### Repeal

4—The *Cinema Act 1962* is repealed.

### Dissolution of the Cinema Board

5—The Cinema Board is dissolved.

### Legal proceedings and documents

6—On and from the commencement day—

(a) legal proceedings instituted by or against the Cinema Board before the commencement day and pending on that day may be continued by or against the Crown; and

(b) legal proceedings by or against the Cinema Board to enforce a right that accrued before the commencement day and in existence on that day may be instituted by or against the Crown; and

(c) a judgment or order of a court obtained by or against the Cinema Board may be enforced by or against the Crown; and

(d) a document addressed to, and purporting to have been served on, the Cinema Board is to be taken to have been served on the Crown.

**Administration**

7—Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1990*—

- (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Justice; and
- (b) the Department responsible to the Minister for Justice in relation to the administration of this Act is the Department of Justice.
