AN ACT to amend the Commercial and Inquiry Agents Act 1974.

[Royal Assent 2 December 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Commercial and Inquiry Agents Short title. Amendment Act 1983.

Commencement.

- **2**—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the day on which this Act receives the royal assent.
- (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

**3**—In this Act, the Commercial and Inquiry Agents Act 1974\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 2 of Principal Act (Interpre**4**—Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "Attorney-General's Department" from the definition of "Secretary" and substituting "Law Department".

Amendment of section 7 of Principal Act (Duration of licences)

- 5—Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
  - (a) by omitting from subsection (1) "a period of 12 months" and substituting "the specified period";
  - (b) by omitting from subsection (1) "previously"; and
  - (c) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:
    - (1A) For the purposes of subsection (1), the "specified period" means a period of—
      - (a) 1 year;
      - (b) 2 years; or
      - (c) 3 years,

as specified in the application for the grant or renewal of that licence.

Application of

**6**—Section 7 (1) of the Principal Act, as amended by this Act, section 7 of Principal Act, applies only to a licence granted or renewed on or after the day on which this Act commences.
