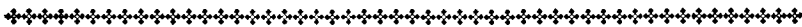

AN ACT to authorise the expenditure by certain Local Bodies of a portion of their revenues for the purpose of the Celebration of the Coronation of His Majesty King George the Sixth. [1 April, 1937.]

BE it enacted by his Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Coronation Celebration Act, 1937.*

2 It shall be lawful for any local body as defined by the *Local Bodies Loans Act, 1881*, to expend, during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, for the purposes of the celebration of the coronation of His Majesty King George the Sixth, such sum, not exceeding one-half per centum of its estimated revenue for that financial year, as such local body may think fit.
