AN ACT to authorise the expenditure by certain Local Bodies of a portion of their revenues for the purpose of the Celebration of the Coronation of His Majesty King George the Sixth. [1 April, 1937.]

BE it enacted by his Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

## Coronation Celebration.

A.D. 1937.

Authorisation of expenditure by local bodies. 2 It shall be lawful for any local body as defined by the Local Bodies Loans Act, 1881, to expend, during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, for the purposes of the celebration of the coronation of His Majestv King George the Sixth, such sum, not exceeding one-half per centum of its estimated revenue for that financial year, as such local body may think fit.
