AN ACT to amend the Criminal Code.

[15 December 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Criminal Code Act (No. 2) Short title and 1976.
- (2) The Criminal Code, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Code.

Rape.

- **2** Section 185 of the Code is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(2) Proceedings under Part VII of the *Justices Act* 1959 for the committal of any person for trial by the Supreme Court in respect of a charge under subsection (1)—
 - (a) shall be heard by a magistrate sitting alone; and
 - (b) shall be heard in closed court unless the magistrate otherwise directs.".
