AN ACT to amend the Criminal Code.

[Royal Assent 18 April 1989]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Code Amendment Act 1989*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal assent. Commencement.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Criminal Code** is referred to as the Code.

4—Chapter XXI of the Code is repealed.

5—Section 268 of the Code is amended by omitting “attached to the soil”.
