CONSOLIDATED FUND APPROPRIATION ACT 1988-1989

No. 45 of 1988

AN ACT to issue and apply from the Consolidated Fund a sum for the service of the financial year ending on 30th June 1989, to appropriate the supplies granted by Parliament for that year, to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money on behalf of the State for that year, and to make provision with respect to the approval of the issue and application of money from the Consolidated Fund for the financial year ended on 30th June 1988.

[Royal Assent 30 November 1988]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Consolidated Fund Short litle. Appropriation Act 1988–1989.

2—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st Commencement. July 1988.

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Issue and application of \$727 037 995.

Appropriation of supplies.

3—The Treasurer may issue from the Consolidated Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the financial year ending on 30th June 1989, the sum of \$727 037 995.

4—The sums granted by this Act and the Consolidated Fund Supply Act 1988-1989, from the Consolidated Fund towards making good the supply granted to Her Majesty for the service of the financial year ending on 30th June 1989, amounting as appears by Schedule 1 to the sum of \$1 216 414 995 are appropriated for the purposes of the recurrent services and of the works and services specified in Schedule 2 in relation to the financial year ending on 30th June 1989.

Sum available for purposes specified in Schedule 2.

Power to borrow money.

Approval of \$32 772 186-87 from Consolidated Fund for financial year ended on 30th June 1988. 5—The sum specified in section 4 is made available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor in respect of any of the purposes specified in Schedule 2.

6—In accordance with the Financial Agreement, the Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing of \$27 657 500 on behalf of the State and such other sums as may be required for the purposes of the State.

7—The issue and application of \$32 772 186.87 from the Consolidated Fund pursuant to sections 10 (2) and (3), 11 (2) and (3), and 12 (1) and (2) of the *Public Account Act 1986* and regulations 20 and 21 set forth in Schedule II to the *Audit Act 1918* for the purposes specified in Schedule 3 in respect of the financial year ended on 30th June 1988 is approved.
