CROWN LANDS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (No. 3).

No. 72 of 1966.

AN ACT to provide for the sale of certain land of the Crown to the Hobart Legacy Club, and to provide for incidental and consequential matters.

[22 December 1966.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Crown Lands (Miscelland incorporation. Short title and incorporation.
- (2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the Crown Lands Act 1935.
- **2**—(1) The Commissioner may, for the sum of two Sale of thousand dollars, sell the land of the Crown specified in the Coningham schedule for the purposes of its use by, or for the purposes of, to Hobart Legacy Club.
- (2) Subject to subsection (3) of this section, for the purposes of giving effect to the sale under this section of the land referred to in subsection (1) thereof, the Governor may,

in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, grant that land to the National Executors and Trustees Company of Tasmania Limited for an estate in fee simple.

(3) A grant fee of six dollars is required to be paid before a grant is made of the land referred to in this section.

All that area of land containing 16a. 0r. 31p. situate in the Town of Coningham in the Parish of Coningham in the Land District of Buckingham, and being the land shown surrounded by red boundary lines on Survey Plan 1405 filed and registered in the office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart in Tasmania.

GOVERNOR'S SALARY.

No. 73 of 1966.

AN ACT to amend the Governor's Salary Act 1951.

[Reserved, 20 July 1966; Royal Assent proclaimed, 29 March 1967.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Governor's Salary Act 1966.
- (2) The Governor's Salary Act 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Salary of Administrator. 2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the words "four thousand dollars" and substituting therefor the words "six thousand dollars".
