

## COSGROVE PARK.

---

No. 17 of 1967.

AN ACT to amend the *Cosgrove Park Act* 1962.

[17 July 1967.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Cosgrove Park Act* 1967.

(2) The *Cosgrove Park Act* 1962 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

The second  
schedule.

**2** The second schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting, after the heading "*Land that may be transferred to the nominated association.*", the headings:—

"CITY OF LAUNCESTON.

"4 acres 0 roods 8 perches.";

and

(b) by adding, at the end thereof, the following paragraph:—

"4 acres 1 rood 33  $\frac{3}{10}$  perches.

"Commencing at the north west angle of 4 acres 0 roods 8 perches transferred to the Ainslie House Association on Waveney Street and bounded on the south west by 1 foot 0 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches north westerly along that street on the north west by 428 feet 4 inches north easterly along Peel Street on the north east by 613 feet 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches south easterly in several bearings along Wellington Street on the south east by 119 feet 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches south westerly along part of 26 acres 3 roods 29  $\frac{3}{10}$  perches acquired for a Sanitorium and Home for Invalids again on the south east by 384 feet 11 inches south westerly in two bearings along Lot 34585 purchased by the Commonwealth of Australia along 0 acres 1 rood 15  $\frac{7}{10}$  perches acquired by the Commonwealth of Australia and again along part of 26 acres 3 roods 29  $\frac{3}{10}$  perches aforesaid again on the north west by 305 feet north easterly along 4 acres 0 roods 8 perches aforesaid and thence on the south by 715 feet 1 inch westerly again along that land to the point of commencement as the same is shown on Plan 1880 filed and registered in the Office of the Surveyor-General and Secretary for Lands at Hobart."
