AN ACT to amend the Child Protection Act 1974. [17 December 1975]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:----

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Child Protection Act 1975. Short title and citation.

(2) The Child Protection Act 1974 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 The Principal Act is amended by inserting the following section after section 9:—

Hospital orders.

"9A—(1) Where, as provided by section 9, a child has been taken to a hospital for the purpose of being examined by a paediatrician, the Medical Superintendent of the hospital may, on the application of the Board or an authorized officer, issue a certificate authorizing the child to be kept in the hospital for a period of 3 days clear of the date of the certificate whereupon it shall be lawful to keep the child in the hospital in accordance with the certificate.

"(2) A child who is kept in a hospital pursuant to subsection (1) shall not be discharged from the hospital while a certificate is still in force otherwise than by the direction of the Board or an authorized officer."
