

## CONSOLIDATED REVENUE DEFICIT (FUNDING).

---

No. 56 of 1953.

AN ACT to authorize the funding of the deficit in the Consolidated Revenue for the financial year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1952.

[16 November, 1953.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Consolidated Revenue Deficit (Funding) Act 1953*.

Power to borrow £552,171 4s. to fund deficit for 1951-52.

**2** The Treasurer may borrow any sums of money, not exceeding £552,171 4s., for the purpose of funding the deficit in the Consolidated Revenue for the financial year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1952.

## GUEST HOUSES REGISTRATION.

---

No. 57 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Guest Houses Registration Act 1937*. [16 November, 1953.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Guest Houses Registration Act 1953*.

(2) The *Guest Houses Registration Act 1937*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall commence on the first day of July, 1954.
