

**CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND
APPROPRIATION (No. 2) 1970-1971.**

No. 29 of 1971.

AN ACT to grant and supply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1971, and to appropriate the supplies granted by Parliament for that year. [5 May 1971]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Consolidated Revenue Fund Appropriation Act (No. 2) 1970-1971.* Short title.

2 The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1971 the sum of \$63,315. Issue and application of \$63,315.

3 The sum issued and applied pursuant to section two is appropriated for the purposes expressed in the schedule. Appropriation of supplies.
