ANALYSIS

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of references to Chief Secretary.

AN ACT to amend certain Acts containing references to the Chief Secretary.

[11 November 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Chief Secretary (Statutory References) Act 1976*. Short title.

2—(1) Subject to this Act, any Act containing a reference to the Chief Secretary is amended by omitting therefrom the words “Chief Secretary”, wherever they occur, and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “Minister”.

(2) This section does not apply to the Acts specified in Schedule I or to any agreement or form of agreement set out in an Act, whether as a schedule thereto or otherwise.

(3) The Acts specified in Schedule II are amended in the manner specified therein.

SCHEDULE II

Tasmanian Orchestra (Agreement) Act 1948

Section 2 is amended by omitting the definition of “the Minister”.

State Sinking Fund Act 1929

(20 Geo. V No. 27)

Section 4 is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the words “the Chief Secretary” and substituting therefor the words “another Minister appointed by the Premier”.
