AN ACT to amend the *Drainage Act* 1934.
[15 November, 1937.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Drainage Act* 1937.

Short title.

2—(1) Where the Governor is satisfied that the number of persons resident in any area is not sufficient to provide a board of seven trustees as provided by section eight of the Principal Act, the Governor, by proclamation, may direct that such area shall be administered by a board of five trustees.

Power to Governor to reduce number of trustees in certain cases.

Drainage.

(2) Upon the publication of such proclamation—

i. If a trust has already been constituted, and—

(a) Five trustees remain in office, they shall comprise the board for the area :

(b) Less than five, but not less than three, trustees remain in office, they shall hold an election as provided by the Principal Act for the election of a sufficient number of trustees to make a total of five :

(c) Less than three trustees remain in office, the Governor may cause an election to be held, as provided by section eleven of the Principal Act in the case of a new area, for the election of a sufficient number of trustees to make a total of five : and

(d) No trustees remain in office, the area, for the purposes of an election, shall be regarded as a new area :

ii. Any three members of the board, whether those remaining in office or otherwise, shall constitute a quorum of the board : and

iii. The retirement of trustees elected as provided by this section shall be in accordance with transitory provisions to be prescribed for ensuring the retirement of trustees in proper rotation.

Expiry of Act.

3 This Act shall expire on the date of the gazettal of a proclamation made under section eight of the *Statute Law Revision Act 1934* effecting in the Principal Act as from the date of such gazettal the amendments made by this Act with such alterations, if any, as may be required to adapt the same for incorporation in the reprint of the Principal Act.
