# AN ACT to amend the Drainage Act 1934. [21 December, 1939.]

A.D. 1939.

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Drainage Act* 1939.

Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by adding at the Amendment d of section eight thereof the following new subsection (5) — ONLY NO. 44. end of section eight thereof the following new subsection (5)—

"(5) Where the Governor is satisfied that owing to the New subsection of the subsect small number of persons resident in any area it is impracticable to constitute a board under the foregoing provisions of this section, the Governor by proclamation may direct that

- A.D. 1939. such area shall be administered by a Board of three trustees; and thereupon the following provisions shall apply in relation to such area—
  - I. One member of the Board shall be appointed by the Governor and shall hold office during his pleasure:
  - II. Two trustees shall be elected as provided by this Act, and shall hold office for two years; but at the end of the first year such one of the elected trustees as may be agreed between them, or, failing such agreement, as the Governor may direct, shall retire from office:
  - III. Upon the publication of such proclamation as afore-said the Board shall be constituted as in the case of a new area; and if a board has previously been constituted for such area all property, rights, powers, duties, obligations, and liabilities of the pre-existing board shall, by virtue of this section, rest in, belong to, devolve upon, and be held, exercised, and carried out by the new Board in the same manner in all respects as if it were the original board: and
  - IV. Any two members of such Board shall constitute a quorum, but where two members only are present at any meeting, any question upon which they differ shall be deferred until all the members are present.".
