"(2) For the purposes of this section the Governor, on the recommendation of the Council, may by proclamation—

- (a) declare the degrees registrable under this section; and
- (b) appoint—
 - (i) how they may be referred to in English; and
 - (ii) the abbreviations by which they may be referred to.

"(3) In this section 'degree' includes fellowship, membership, diploma, or licence.".

AN ACT to amend the *Dentists Act* 1919. [17 December 1963.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

Scope of dental mechanics' operations. 1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Dentists Act 1963.

(2) The *Dentists Act* 1919, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section thirty-eight of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection(1) thereof; and
- (b) by omitting subsection (1A) thereof.
