

“(2) For the purposes of this section the Governor, on the recommendation of the Council, may by proclamation—

(a) declare the degrees registrable under this section; and

(b) appoint—

(i) how they may be referred to in English; and

(ii) the abbreviations by which they may be referred to.

“(3) In this section ‘degree’ includes fellowship, membership, diploma, or licence.”.

DENTISTS.

No. 92 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Dentists Act 1919*.
[17 December 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Dentists Act 1963*.

(2) The *Dentists Act 1919*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Scope of dental mechanics' operations.

2 Section thirty-eight of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection (1) thereof; and

(b) by omitting subsection (1A) thereof.
