AN ACT to amend the Dangerous Drugs Act 1959. [26 November 1971.]

 $\mathbf{B}^{\mathbf{E}}$ it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and concert of the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:----

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs Act (No. Short title and citation. 2) 1971.

(2) The Dangerous Drugs Act 1959, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Sale, &c., of dangerous drugs prohibited.

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2 Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (7) thereof and substituting therefor the following subsection:—

"(7) In this section, 'maximum permissible quantity', in relation to a drug, means the quantity specified in the second column of the schedule opposite the name of that drug in the first column of the schedule.".
