AN ACT to provide for the Exercise of certain Statutory Functions committed to the Director of Agriculture. [6 December, 1937.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Department of Agriculture short title Act 1937.

Provision for exercise of certain functions.

- 2 In the event of the position of Director of Agriculture being at any time abolished the following provisions shall thereupon come into operation and be applied—
 - 1. The Governor shall appoint some person as a member of the Board of Control and Appeal under Part VIII. of the Stock Act 1932 in place of the Director of Agriculture, and such person shall be subject to the provisions of subsection (5) of section thirty-two of that Act:

n. References to the Director as Chairman of the Board aforesaid shall be construed as references to the Chief Veterinary Officer who shall be Chairman of the said Board in lieu of the Director as provided by the said Act:

III. The Stock Medicines Board, established by the Stock Medicines, Fertilisers, and Pesticides Act 1936, shall consist of the Chief Inspector of Stock, who shall be Chairman thereof, the Government Analyst, and one other member to be appointed by the Governor: and

iv. Except as aforesaid where any reference is made in any Act or regulations to the Director of Agriculture the same shall be construed as a reference to the Secretary for Agriculture.
