“burial ground” means sections N and O of the Queenstown Public Cemetery as delineated on the plan thereof in the municipal office of the Municipality of Queenstown in which are buried persons who lost their lives in the disasters at the Mount Lyell and North Mount Lyell mines on the twelfth day of October 1912;

“the corporation” means the warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Queenstown;

“tombstone” includes headstone, monument, and vault.

**3**—(1) The corporation may—

- (a) remove all tombstones, railings, and other erections from the graves in the burial ground;
- (b) enclose, drain, level, and turf the burial ground; and
- (c) erect or permit to be erected a monument to all persons buried therein.

(2) The corporation shall place all tombstones removed under this section along the perimeter of the burial ground so that their inscriptions are legible to visitors.

(3) The corporation shall take care that tombstones removed under this section are not broken, but are not liable for any damage thereto unless it is wilful.

**4** Before proceeding with the removal of tombstones under section three the corporation shall—

- (a) cause to be prepared a statement setting out the names and any other personal particulars on the tombstones proposed to be removed by it; and
- (b) keep the statement in its municipal office and make it available for inspection by any person free of charge.

## DAIRY PRODUCE.

---

### No. 6 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the *Dairy Produce Act 1932*.

[29 April 1970.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Dairy Produce Act 1970*.

(2) The *Dairy Produce Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Provisions  
as to testers

**2** Section eight of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(7) Where the Director is satisfied that a person is competent to act as a tester or grader of any dairy produce he may issue a temporary certificate to that person authorizing him, during such period as may be specified in the certificate, and subject to such conditions (if any) as may be so specified, to test or grade (as the case may be) that dairy produce; and, in relation to any testing or grading of dairy produce authorized by the certificate, that person shall, for the purposes of this section, be deemed to hold a prescribed certificate.”.

Employment  
of certificated

**3** Section twelve A of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(3) Where the Director is satisfied that a person is competent to make cheese or butter he may issue a temporary certificate authorizing that person to be employed as a butter maker or a cheese maker (as the case may be) for such period as may be specified in the certificate, and subject to such conditions (if any) as may be so specified; and where in accordance with that certificate that person is employed as a butter maker or a cheese maker he shall be deemed for the purposes of this section to be a certificated butter maker or a certificated cheese maker, as the case may be.”.

## MOWBRAY MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL LOAN GUARANTEE.

### No. 7 of 1970.

AN ACT to authorize the Treasurer to guarantee the repayment of a loan proposed to be made by the Launceston Bank for Savings to the Association known as the Mowbray Memorial Swimming Pool Incorporated and the payment of the interest payable in respect of that loan, and to pay a certain proportion of the interest payable in respect of that loan, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.
