DAIRY PRODUCE

ANALYSIS

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AN ACT to amend the Dairy Produce Act 1932.

[19 December 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Dairy Produce Act 1974*. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Dairy Produce Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

2 Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the definition of “dairy” the following definition:—

“ ‘dairy blend’ means any substance made from vegetable oil and milk fat and intended to be used, or capable of being used, as a substitute for butter;”
and

(b) by inserting at the end of the definition of “dairy produce” the words “and dairy blend”.

Restriction of
use of milk
products in
margarine and
butter
substitutes, &c.

3 Section 30 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (2) after the word “substance” the words “(other than dairy blend that complies with the prescribed requirements)”.

Regulations.

4 Section 34 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (l) the following paragraph:—

“(la) The package in which margarine and butter substitutes shall be contained and the form and manner of marking or labelling the package;”.

Expiry of Act.

5 This Act shall expire on the thirty-first day of December 1975.
