AN ACT to amend the Deceased Persons' Estates Duties Act 1931. [5 June 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Deceased Persons' Estates* Short title and *Duties Act* 1974.
- (2) The Deceased Persons' Estates Duties Act 1931, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Prohibition of dealings with estate of without certificate of Commissioner.

2 Section 31A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from estate of decreased person subsection (3A) all the words in that subsection following the words "not exceeding" and substituting therefor "\$3 000".
