AGENT-GENERAL.

No. 19 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Agent-General Act 1911. [18 June 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Agent-General Act 1970.
- (2) The Agent-General Act 1911, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January 1970.

Salary of Agent-General.

Short title

- 2 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by omitting subsection (1) of that section and substituting therefor the following subsection:-
 - "(1) The Agent-General shall be paid a salary—
 - (a) at the rate of nine thousand four hundred and fifty dollars a year; or
 - (b) such other rate as the Governor, on the recommendation of the Public Service Tribunal, may, after the first day of January 1971, determine.";
 - (b) by inserting in subsection (1B) of that section, after the word "Agent-General" (first occurring), the words ", pursuant to paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section,".

DAYLIGHT SAVING.

AN ACT to amend the Daylight Saving Act 1968. [30 June 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Daylight Saving Act 1970. and citation.

- (2) The Daylight Saving Act 1968 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND SUPPLY 1970-1971.

No. 21 of 1970.

AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1971. [30 June 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Consolidated Revenue Fund short title. Supply Act 1970-1971.
- 2 There may be issued and applied towards making good the Issue and supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year \$20,413,600. ending on the thirtieth day of June 1971 the sum of \$26,413,600 out of the Consolidated Revenue, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule, and the Treasurer is authorized to issue and apply the moneys so authorized to be issued and applied.

3 The sum specified in section two is made available to satisfy the Sum available warrants under the hand of the Governor in respect of any purposes purposes set forth in the schedule.

4 The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts for any Credit to be sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any warrant mentioned given to the in section three, and the receipts of the respective persons to whom his accounts. any sums of money are so paid are a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his accounts for such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for them accordingly.
