AN ACT to amend the *Devonport Water Act 1889* and to authorise the Council of the Municipality of Devonport to borrow a further sum of Thirty-six thousand nine hundred Pounds for the purposes of the said Act. [17 June, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 It shall be lawful for the Council, in addition to any moneys borrowed for the purposes of the Principal Act, to borrow under the provisions of the *Local Bodies Loans Act* 1881 any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of thirty-six thousand nine hundred pounds for the purposes of the Principal Act and for defraying the expenses of and incidental to the preparation, passing, and carrying out of this Act.

3 All moneys raised or borrowed under this Act shall be subject to the provisions of the Principal Act in the same manner as if such money had been raised or borrowed under that Act.
