

**AN ACT to amend the *Extradition Tasmania***  
***Act 1877.* [27 August, 1935.]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Extradition Act 1935.*
