AN ACT to amend the *Education Act 1932*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Education Act 1939*.

A.D. 1939. **2** Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the words “next following the examination upon the results of which the same are granted” in subsection (1) and substituting therefor the words “in the first year in respect of which the bursary is tenable”: and

II. By expunging subsections (2) and (3) and substituting therefor the following new subsections (2), (3) and (4):—

“(2) Headmasters of schools may nominate children who have attended their schools for bursaries under this Part as prescribed; and the nomination of each child shall be in the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed particulars of the scholastic record of such child.

“(3) The by-laws may provide that the number of nominations to be made in respect of any school may be limited in accordance with the number of children attending that school.

“(4) Bursaries shall be granted by the Board after consideration of the nominations therefor, and of such evidence of ability as the Board may require, or as may be prescribed.”

3 Any acts or proceedings of the Bursaries Board prior to and in anticipation of the commencement of this Act in relation to the award of bursaries in respect of the year one thousand nine hundred and forty, which could have been validly done or taken if this Act had been in force, shall be deemed to be valid and effectual as if this Act had been in operation during the period in which those acts or proceedings were done or taken.

4 This Act shall remain in force until the thirty-first day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty, and no longer.
