EDUCATION.

No. 10 of 1972.**AN ACT to amend the *Education Act 1932.***

[13 July 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act 1972.*(2) The *Education Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Board of Technical Education.

2 Section nineteen B of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the word "ten" and substituting therefor the word "eleven"; and

(b) by omitting the word "and" occurring after paragraph (b) of subsection (3) thereof and by adding at the end of that subsection the following word and paragraph:—

"; and

"(d) one shall be a person appointed on the nomination of the governing body of the Tasmanian Technical Colleges Staff Society."
