AN ACT to amend the Education Act 1932.

[30 November 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Education Act 1978*.

**2** Section 4 of the *Education Act 1932\** is amended by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsections:—

(5A) The Director of North West Community Education appointed under this section shall, if the Minister so recommends to the Governor—

- (a) notwithstanding subsections (4) and (5), be paid such salary and allowances as are specified in his instrument of appointment; and
- (b) be appointed for such term as is specified in his instrument of appointment.

(5B) The director referred to in subsection (5A) shall be deemed to be an employee within the meaning of the *Superannuation Act 1938* and the *Retirement Benefits Act 1970*.

(5C) The director referred to in subsection (5A) is an employee for the purposes of the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950*.
