AN ACT to authorize the Teachers' Salaries Board to vary certain determinations under Part IVB of the Education Act 1932 in certain respects. [29 November 1956.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation. **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act* (No. 2) 1956.

(2) The *Education Act* 1932, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Variation of salary determinations. 2—(1) Notwithstanding anything in Part IVB of the Principal Act, the Teachers' Salaries Board may vary any determination under that Part that is in force at the commencement of this section to such extent as may be necessary in order to increase the salary or wage of each officer to whom the determination relates by an amount not exceeding—

- (a) sixty-seven pounds twelve shillings a year, in the case of a male officer who is of or over the age of twenty-one years or who, if under that age, is married;
- (b) fifty pounds fourteen shillings a year, in the case of a female officer who is of or over the age of twenty-one years; and
- (c) thirty-three pounds sixteen shillings a year, in the case of any other officer.

(2) Where a determination is varied under the authority of this section it has effect, as so varied, from such date, being not earlier than the fifteenth day of April 1956, as may be specified in the determination, notwithstanding anything in subsection (1) of section forty-six U of the Principal Act.
