AN ACT to amend the *Education Act* 1932. [19 December 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Education Act* (No. 3) Short title and 1973.

(2) The *Education Act* 1932, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section thirty-four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) the word "nine" and substituting therefor the word "ten";

- (b) by transposing the word "and" at the end of paragraph
 (d) of that subsection to the end of paragraph (e) thereof; and
- (c) by adding at the end of that subsection the following paragraph:—
 - "(f) one shall be a person who is qualified in the field of pre-school education.".

Salary of member of Teaching Service. **3**—(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any Act or award made thereunder, no member of the Teaching Service shall have his salary reduced by reason of being transferred or appointed to another position in the Teaching Service as a result of the exercise by the Council of the College of Advanced Education of its functions under the Advanced Education Act 1968.

(2) Nothing in this section prejudices the operation of any regulations made under paragraph (r) of subsection (1) of section forty-seven of the Principal Act.

(3) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the commencement of the Advanced Education Act 1968.
